We are honored and pleased to share that Thursday, March 29, 2018, The Maine Children's Home for Little Wanderers' <u>George</u> <u>J. & Mary S. Mitchell Adoption Unit</u> received renewal of their Hague Accreditation by The Council on Accreditation. We remain the only Maine-based Hague Accredited agency statewide. The Hague Convention is an international treaty created to ensure that intercountry adoptions are in the best interests of children and to prevent abduction, exploitation, sale or trafficking of children.
