HERE ARE SOME HIGHLIGHTS OF WHAT WE WERE ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH TOGETHER:

Counseling clients had 2,437 telehealth appointments and 2,818 in-person appointments throughout the year.

FAMILY COUNSELING CENTER

54 hours of post-adoption assistance were given to families.

7 reunion searches were conducted, and 3 international adoptions were finalized.

FAMILY ADOPTION PROGRAM

Teen parents were enrolled from 4 academic avenues in Maine.

2 graduated in 2021, and **7** more are anticipated to graduate in 2022.

TEEN PARENT EDUCATION PROGRAM


Maine Children's Home (MCH) has been adapting to the <u>evolving needs</u> of families and children for the past 123 years.

2021 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Maine Children's Home utilized unrestricted endowment funds to support a shortfall in operating revenue. Our need to use endowment funds continues to decline as we find efficiencies in operating costs while still continuing growth in services and service delivery.
